- We ask for a voluntary donation of £2 per child to help raise funds for this worthy cause.

Why this matters:

By taking part, our school community will be contributing to the national effort to support vulnerable children and young people. Important details:

- Children may wear spotty clothes for the day instead of their uniform. It's a non-uniform day with a fun twist!
- Normal school rules apply (i.e., clothes should be suitable for school, safe and respectful).
- If you would prefer your child not to dress up, they may still wear their school uniform and are still welcome to join in by donating and learning about the cause.
