Welcome to the second half of the Autumn Term and to our half-termly curriculum update newsletter! We would like to take this opportunity to tell you all about the exciting half-term ahead. This newsletter is where you can find out all about what your child will be learning over the coming weeks, along with ideas and suggestions for some activities you could try to support their learning at home.

What are we learning during this theme?

Your child will start our theme by completing a history enquiry: *What was our school like in the past?* They will learn what our school was like long ago, making comparisons between now and then and learning about events within living memory and beyond living memory. In geography, we will be looking at where we live in the world and locating our school. We will also be exploring our school grounds, observing the changing seasons as we move from autumn to winter.

This half term we are very excited to be taking part in Christmas traditions and celebrations. We will be preparing our Christmas production which we are looking forward to sharing with you. We will also be planning a walk of the local area as part of our history and geography sessions.

Share your child's reading book - we encourage 5 reads per week at home to earn team points in school.

This half term year one will also begin bringing spellings home to learn. They will have a 'spelling quiz' every Monday in class and then will bring home new spellings.
