## EYFS Christmas Production 2025

I am writing to let you know about the arrangements for the Christmas Productions for children in the Early Years. This year the children will be learning and performing 'I Spy Christmas.' This is a lovely Christmas Nativity which involves children from both classes in various roles. This will be performed to parents on Tuesday 16th December at 9:30 and 1:30 and it lasts approximately 30 minutes. Performances will be held in the Red Hall.

Entry will be via a wristband and booking will be via an online booking form. We will notify you when this is open and invite you to book a place. Places are limited to 2 per family (not per child if you have more than one child in EYFS). However, in the case of split families, it is possible for parents to book separately. If you need further information regarding this, please ask the office. Younger siblings are able to attend as long as they can sit on their parent's lap. The booking form will open on **Monday 17th November at 10am and close on Monday 24th November at 10am** After this point, if there are any further available wristbands, we will release these on a first come, first served basis. We will notify you when the wristbands are available for collection.

It is not possible for parents to take photographs/videos during the productions. This is due to safeguarding. However, we will film a version of the production which will be available to view via a private Youtube link. We ask for a small donation of £2 per seat for the performance, payable through Scopy. This will also include access to a recording of the productions
